

# Andy & Judy



New England natives Andy & Judy Daigle have been singing together since 2009 and began writing songs in 2011. Today, this talented folk duo performs regularly at coffeehouses, festivals, libraries, and stages throughout the Northeast, Mid-Atlantic, Midwest and Great Lakes Regions. They have also been featured on popular folk music radio programs. Their albums *Follow Your Dream*, *This Old Town*, and *Reflection*, did well on the Folk DJ charts and were chosen as Top picks of the year by Four Strong Winds (John Rumsey), KVMR Nevada City, CA. Their latest CD, *Reflections*, was in the Top 25 on the Folk DJ chart for three months reaching a high of #9. It was also named a Top Album of the year and Andy & Judy were listed in the Top Artists of the year.

Andy & Judy do a masterful job of involving the audience in their performances. Sing-a-longs and smiles are the norm at one of their concerts. Their close harmonies blend Judy's evocative alto and Andy's deep baritone. Beginning instrumentally with a classic folk guitar base, Andy & Judy have deepened their sound through the addition of mandolin, banjo, piano, harmonica, ukulele, and with support musicians, bass and percussion. The instrumental complexity presented on their five CDs, *Riverbend* (2012), *Dragonfly* (2014), *Follow Your Dream* (2015), *This Old Town* (2017), and *Reflections* (2018) support the increasing lyrical depth of their compositions.

Even though their songwriting style has its roots firmly planted in traditional and folk music, the influences of country, gospel, blues, and bluegrass, can be heard in their songs. Historical people, places and events are common themes. Their songs are carefully crafted and performed so that the listener experiences all of the emotions woven into their music.
